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## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **SLLS MERIDIAN ACADEMY SUMMER GROUPS AND PROGRAMS 2017 June 5-16, 2017**

**Speech Language Learning Systems, Inc.** is excited to offer programs through our **SLLS Meridian Academy** that target strategy instruction to enhance speech, vocabulary, reading, and writing success. The following outlines some of the general policy and procedures regarding the summer programs offered.

**Registration:** Enrollment is open for elementary through high school age students. Please complete the registration form and return it with your deposit. Registration form(s) and deposit(s) are due by April 13, 2017. Please make checks payable to SLLS.

**Fees:** A \$100 nonrefundable deposit per group is required with registration prior to placement in group(s). Final balance is due prior to first group meeting. Services are billed at an hourly group therapeutic rate (\$57 to \$67 per hour) based on actual number of group participants. The Half-Day Literacy Boot camp is billed at a group rate of \$30 per hour for the intensive two-week program. Please make checks payable to SLLS. Necessary forms will be mailed, and if applicable, a screening or consultation will be scheduled.

**Attendance:** Individual programming may be optimal if schedule conflicts prevent consistent group attendance. While attendance at all sessions is recommended, rescheduling for a missed session can be arranged for an additional fee.

**Refund Policy:** SLLS reserves the right to limit, cancel, or consolidate groups. Refunds, which would include the deposit of \$100, will be given only if a group is cancelled or does not meet minimum enrollment. No refund will be given for a student who withdraws from the group(s) after the summer program has begun.

**Group Placement/Additional Information:** To facilitate an optimal group experience, careful consideration is given to student placement in groups. Every attempt is made to try and place students with peers who function at a similar skill level and are of similar age/grade through collection of information via the parent intake process. Information regarding school performance and prior educational, cognitive, or speech-language testing is welcomed prior to the group onset. This information will support the learning process for your child by assisting in group placement, thus maximizing the benefits of service from the specialists leading the groups. For select groups, additional background information and a potential speech-language screening or consultation may be required to assist in group placement.

**Waiting Room Policy:** Our waiting room is a busy place, particularly during the summer months, and we appreciate your effort in assisting us in maintaining a quiet environment as we work with your children. As such, we ask that students are to be picked up immediately following their session, and headphones be used with electronic devices to ensure the comfort of all those in the waiting room.
